This scholarship is in the amount of \$1000.00.

Requirements for eligibility are as follows:

1. Currently a female graduating senior.
2. Minimum GPA of 2.5.
3. Must not use, buy, or sell illegal narcotics or drugs in any form.
4. Must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States.
5. Must include one letter of recommendation.
6. Must include a transcript of grades.
7. Must use the funds awarded within one calendar year from the official award date.
8. Must describe financial need for scholarship.
9. Must Include a one page essay on one of the following topics:
 - a. Your feelings on patriotism;
 - b. How you feel about this land;
 - c. How you could best serve your community.

Application Deadline: Last Friday in April.

Selection:

Final selection of the scholarship recipient will be determined on the basis of ability, aptitude, character, determination, seriousness of purpose, and financial need.

Schedule of payment:

One-third will be paid upon receipt of verified registration information.

One third will be paid each of the ensuing terms upon presentation of a copy of grades for the previous term. A passing grade will be required to continue receiving the balance of the scholarship.

There is a deadline of 1 year from date of award to claim your scholarship monies. If not claimed, all monies will revert back to the American Legion Auxiliary.
