3. Maintained good sportsmanship during the competition

If selected to receive this money, you must fulfil the following:

1. Maintain a full time college student status or take a minimum of 12 credit hours per term
2. Maintain a G.P.A of at least a 2.0
3. Submit your college transcript to the appropriate Cowboy Mat Club member before winter term starts
4. If attending a trade school, must submit a copy of completion certificate or copy of first term grades (scholarship is void after 1 year if not submitted)

Scholarships are awarded on a points system. Points are awarded for the following:

1. Participation
  - a. Years with Cowboy Mat Club
2. Involvement
  - a. Parent involvement (example: coaching, board or committee member, volunteering, etc.)
  - b. Continued Cowboy Mat Club involvement through high school (example: helping coach, tournament help, fundraising help, mentor, etc.)
3. Presentation of Application
  - a. Cover letter, grades, letter of recommendation, achievement/accomplishments, etc.
