CCHS Graduation Parade Route Details:

- The parade is scheduled for Friday June 5th
 - Staging will begin at 1:30 pm. The parade begins at 3:00 pm.
 - Staging will occur on NW 4th and NW 5th Street between NW Harwood and NW Deer Street (Staging to be ran by Kiwanis)
 - Each Graduate will be assigned a number that corresponds where they will be staged and a time to arrive
 - Prineville Kiwanis is coordinating the staging process
- The parade will begin on the corner of NW 4th and NW Deer and travel East down NW 4th street to Fairview by the public swimming pool
 - Banners of the graduates senior pictures will line NW 4th street
 - At Foundry Four, there will be a station set up where graduates will be announced and programs will be available for pick-up
- The parade will turn South on Fairview and continue on Fairview all the way to Lynn Blvd
 - At the corner of SE 1st and SE Fairview (Pioneer Complex), there will be another station where graduates will be announced and programs will be available for pick up
- The parade will cross Lynn Blvd into the Carey Foster Hall entrance into the fairgrounds
 - Parade will wind through fairgrounds and exit onto Fairgrounds road
 - Parking will be available to view the parade from vehicles to maintain social distancing
- The parade will exit the Fairgrounds onto Fairground Rd. (behind the tennis courts). At this time, graduates will have the opportunity to exit the parade or enter into CCHS parking lot for the stage walk and diploma presentation.

- If a graduate decides to exit the parade early, they will arrange a time to pick up their diploma from CCHS.
- At the designated vehicle exit area, Graduates will exit vehicles stand on an “X” maintaining social distancing
 - Support staff will be present to help facilitate this
 - All efforts will be taken to adhere to state guidelines concerning gathering numbers and social distancing protocol.
- Once a graduate exits the vehicle in the designated “drop-off” area, the driver will pull ahead to a designated pick up area where they can view their graduates crossing the stage
- After crossing the stage, the graduate will return to their vehicle (waiting in the pick-up area) and exit school property.

Other notable Items:

- There will be a professional photographer to take pictures of every graduate receiving their diploma.
- If a parent wants to see their graduate receive their diploma, they need to be in the graduate’s vehicle.
- On school property, spectators must remain in their vehicles to maintain state mandated social distancing requirements.
- Places for community to spectate using social distancing guidelines: 4th street, Fairview, Fairgrounds
- The names of the graduates will be read over speaker systems at Foundry Four (on 4th street) and the corner of 1st and Fairview.
- This parade will take an extended time period and you will be required to enter and exit a vehicle, please wear proper footwear and layers to keep warm.
- We encourage you to wear your cap and gown
- 1 student per vehicle unless you are siblings
