



Crook County High School Building Procedures for Full-Time Schedule

NEW MEASURES BEING INSTITUTED

- Students arriving at the school will enter the school through specifically designated entryways. 9th and 10th graders will enter through the SW Commons doors while 11th and 12th graders will enter through the front doors. Additionally, students arriving by bus will have their own entrance on the SE corner of the Commons.
- To prevent crowding at lunch, Freshman will have their own lunch period separate from other grades. 11th and 12th graders will be released 5 minutes before 10th graders head to lunch and provide time for the halls to clear and for the lunch lines to disperse.
- Staggered passing periods between classes will be implemented. Passing periods will be split into two parts in order to avoid crowding in the halls. 11th and 12th graders will be given 5-minutes to move from class to class followed by a 5-minute passing period for 9th and 10th graders to do the same.

CONTINUING PROTOCOLS

- Students will remain cohorted into groups of fewer than 100
- Seating charts are kept in every class for a minimum of 30-days
- A symptom tracker is kept for all students experiencing symptoms or who have had exposure to potentially COVID positive individuals.
- Daily check-in routines for all student will remain in place. Temperature checks, masks donned and hands sanitized will be required for entry to the school.
- Classroom desks will be sanitized in between each class.
- Custodial staff will continue to disinfect all spaces utilized by students on a daily basis
- Building air receives a “full-flush” so it is replaced every hour.
- Building air filters are being replaced with greater frequency
- High touch areas are cleaned daily by custodial staff
