Note: this must be done from a computer. It cannot be done from a phone.

Go to: HjeShare.com

School code is: cchs (all lowercase letters)

Step 1:

You'll fill in the student's first and last name.

Please enter your email address and phone number

Then click on the green line at the bottom that says: [CLICK HERE TO UPLOAD A STUDENT PORT](#)

From there, it'll pop up a box with the guidelines.

Click next

Step 2: Click on blue line to: [Browse for Portrait Image](#)

Crop the photo as you wish it to be in the yearbook, hit next

Step 3:

Enter Student's grade, first name, last name, and then...

***on the line for Senior Portrait, type the student's first and last name on one line (as you would show in the yearbook).
